《Nursing Care Worker Training Loan System》

How much is the Loan ?

Up to 200,000 yen 【one-time payment during training for practitioners】

※A joint guarantor will be required to apply.

What is the Breakdown of the Loan?

- Payment for practical training,
- Fee for: Materials, Reference books, School supplies and Transportation
- Tuition fees for exam preparation courses,
- Fees for national exams, etc.

Who can apply for the Loan ?

① Someone who has not borrowed from this fund in other prefectures.

② Someone who is enrolled in a practical training school and wishes to become a certified care taker in facilities in Chiba Prefecture.

※This loan is not available with other scholarships or nationally subsidized support systems such as Vocational Training Course Benefits.

※The Living Welfare Educational Subsidy Loan has become available in combination with this loan since April 2020.

What is required to be exempt from paying back the Loan?

① Within one year of a date listed below, either A or B;

A: Day of graduation (completion) of studies at practical training facility

B: Date on which the period of working for the welfare facilities has reached three years

② Must be in Chiba Prefecture

③ Become a Certified Care Taker (must pass the National Exam* and register properly), and then

④ Keep working at this job for at least two years

※You can take the National Care Worker Exam up to three times.

You will be exempted from paying back the Loan if you meet all the 4 of requirements above.

※ You will be **required to pay** the Loan if you drop out of training facility, are not registered as a care worker, quit your care worker job, or changed to another industry

or job outside of Chiba Prefecture.

How to Apply

Please consult with the care worker practitioner training facility you plan to attend.

They will take care of all the application documents on behalf of the students after their entry. Please attach the recommendation form from the school.

Nursing Care Workers Training Loan System

Flow Chart of Application Procedures

↓ 1. Applicants submit prescribed application documents to their respective prescribed practitioner training

- ① Loan Application Form (Form No. 12)
 - ② Resident's card (issued within 3 months prior to the application date)
 - ③ Pledge → (Only applicants with addresses outside the prefecture may submit)
 - ④ Identification documents with a photo of your face
(driver's license, passport, etc.)
 - ⑤ Documents certifying the amount of your most recent income
[Only applicants who are working must submit]
→ (copy of tax filing, withholding slip, etc)
 - ⑥ Copy of residence card (front and back)
(Only applicants who do not have Japanese nationality)
 - ⑦ Consent Form for Handling of Personal Information
- ※ In addition to the above, documents of a joint guarantor are required. For further information, please visit <http://www.chibakenshakyō.net/>.

↓ 2. A training facility submit the above documents together to the Chiba Prefectural Social Welfare Council.

↓ 3. The Social Welfare Council reviews and decides on the loan.

↓ If the loan is decided, the Social Welfare Council will send a loan decision notice, a borrower deed, etc. to your practitioner training facility.

↓ 4. The applicant who is accepted to get a loan (hereafter, called a borrower) submits a loan agreement and other required documents

A borrower should receive a loan agreement form from a practitioner's training facility while at school, fill in the necessary information, and submit it to the practitioner training facility. The loan agreement needs the self-written signature and seal of both sides (borrower and guarantor).

A certificate of seal registration and income from both the borrower and guarantor are also required.

*Please submit them to the Chiba Prefectural Social Welfare Council through the practitioner training facility within 14 days after arrival of the loan decision notice.

↓ 5. Practical training funds are deposited into the borrower's bank account.

↓ 6. The borrower submits an application to the Social Welfare Council for the restitution.

【Those who lack work experience】

If the borrower was unable to take the most recent national care worker examination due to not having at least three years of work experience after completing practitioner training, the borrower should submit the following documents directly to the Chiba Prefectural Social Welfare Council every one year from one

month after the completion of the practitioner training.

- ① Restitution Application
- ② Notification of business engagement (current status report and business engagement period certificate)

【To those who have three year work experience】

●If you have passed the National Care Worker Examination and are engaged in nursing care, please submit the following directly to the Chiba Prefectural Social Welfare Council.

- ① Application of restitution
- ② Notification of Business Engagement (current status report and business engagement period certificate)
- ③ Copy of Nursing Care Worker Registration Certificate

●If you fail the care worker national examination, submit the following:

- ①Application of restitution
- ②A copy of the result of the national nursing care worker examination

*If you cannot pass the national nursing care worker examination in 2 years after completing the practitioner training, you must pay back the loan.

7. Please submit application for exemption from restitution.

After passing the National Nursing Care Worker Examination, and after working as a nursing care staff in Chiba Prefecture for two years, please apply directly to the Chiba Prefecture Social Welfare Council.
